**Old Cutler Bike Path**

**Phase I: From SW 216th Street to SW 136th Street**

### **Project Description:**

This project will re-construct approximately 6 miles of 8-foot Bike Path along the historic Old Cutler Road from SW 216th Street to SW 136th Street. Work includes, but is not limited to, curb and gutter; installation of remedial drainage along the corridor, as necessary; resurface segments of the Bike Path; prune tree roots and place root barriers to prevent future damage to the Bike Path; install 6' high fence adjacent to environmentally protected areas; construct eight (8) trail turn outs along the path; and the installation of regulatory signage for bicyclists and pedestrians.

### **Construction Schedule:**

Construction is anticipated to commence on July 6, 2010 and should be completed by January 2, 2010.\*

\*The Construction Schedule above is weather permitting.

### **Methodology and Efforts:**

All efforts are being made to minimize the impact from the construction activities to the residents, schools and businesses of the area. The area will be restored to its original condition immediately upon the completion of the construction activities. The restoration methodology will include any areas impacted by the project, such as grassy areas, landscaping, sprinkler systems, and other items affected by the construction.
