On behalf of the Mayor and Town Council, you are cordially invited to attend an additional two (2) Public Involvement Meetings to discuss the proposed Town Center Plaza. The Town contracted with a Professional Engineering Firm (Kinley-Hore and Associates, Inc.) to host the Public Involvement Meetings in order to further engage the community on its vision for a proposed Town Center Plaza – located adjacent to our Town Hall Building.

The Town Council previously held five (5) Public Involvement Meetings to develop a conceptual project design, based on the input of the residents. The Town Council wishes to host an additional two (2) meetings to discuss the costs of the project and the individual elements and possible phasing of the project. The *estimated* cost of the proposed project is approximately \$13 million (please find below an itemized cost estimate for each element of the project).
