Code Compliance

Code Compliance Special Magistrate Hearing was held on December 13, 2016. Ten (10) cases were heard at this hearing. The Special Magistrate upheld seven (7) cases, dismissed two (2) cases and approved one (1) line reduction. The next hearing is scheduled for January 10, 2017 at 9:00 AM in the Community Room.

Awards & Certifications Inclusion Readiness Award

- On Wednesday, November 16, the Town's Afterschool Program was recognized by the Advocacy Network on Disabilities' All Children Together' Project for completing Step Two (2) of Five (5) on the Inclusion Readiness Tool (IRT).
- The Town currently serves approximately two hundred (200) youth annually through the Afterschool and Summer Camp Programs.



MPO (TAP) Grant Approval (\$344,259)

- The Miami-Dade Metropolitan Planning Organization Governing Board approved the list of 2016 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) priority projects. The Town has been granted \$344,259 and will match \$144,341 with a total budget of \$488,600 for the Manta Drive Roadway Reconstruction Project.

FDOT Local Agency Program Certification

- The Town has successfully completed the District's assessments and Local Agency's interview and has been granted "Full Certification" to manage LAP Projects in partnership with District 6 Local Program Office.

Grant Professional Certification – Lakeesha Morris, Credential Grant Professional

- The Grant Professional Certification (GPC) is designed to identify individuals with broad-based knowledge and real-world experience in the field of grantsmanship.
- A GPC practitioner is a person of integrity whose broad interest is in building social capital, and helping guide less knowledgeable stakeholders to become truly professional and altruistic practitioners.



Tree City USA Growth Award

- Tree City USA is a program that celebrates the importance of urban tree canopy and improves care of vital city trees
- The Town has received the prestigious designation from the Arbor Foundation every year since 2009 and as of 2016, the Town planted three thousand one hundred and thirty five trees

Cutler Bay Senior High Adult Education Program Open House:

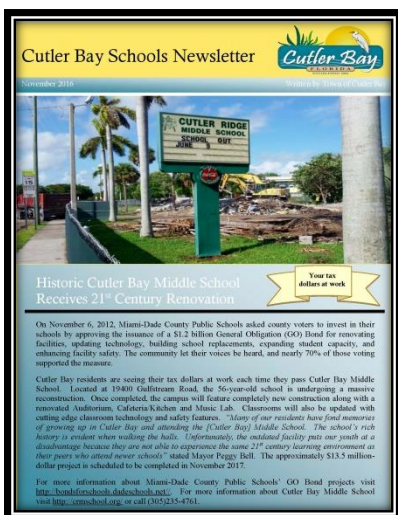
Wednesday, November 16, 2016
