

PROJECT FACTS:

- Project limits:
 - o from SW 184th Street to Old Cutler Road
- > Traffic Circles-Franjo Road at Gulfstream Road and Cutler Ridge Drive
- Lane expansion from two to three lanes (including a center turn lanes and dedicated turn lanes at key intersections)
- New street lighting
- New decorative bus shelters and bus pull-out lanes
- Drainage Improvements
- Ensuring Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance-new ADA ramps and complete ADA accessibility
- New bicycle share lanes

<u>APPROXIMATE COST</u>: **\$16,128,603.02** (\$8,347,373.00 via Miami-Dade County Joint Participation Agreement)

<u>FUNDING SOURCE</u>: Miami-Dade County Joint Participation Agreement, Town's People's Transportation Plan (PTP), the Town's Stormwater Utility Funds, and American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA).

TENTATIVE COMMENCEMENT: June 2024

ESTIMATED TIME OF COMPLETION: June 2026

PROJECT BACKGROUND: This project was identified in the Town of Cutler Bay Complete Streets Corridor Analysis Master Plan. The Town of Cutler Bay is primarily a pedestrian friendly community with a vast network of sidewalks. The goal of this project is to improve public safety, ease traffic congestion, enhance pedestrian mobility, improve function and flow of traffic and beautify the neighborhood with streetscape improvements.
